If there is more than one head/acting head, start with the oldest and only person who resides in this dwelling and was part of this household at least four nights a week on average and has done so over the last four weeks.

[2] Population: D5: What population group does %rostertitle% belong to?

This question must be asked for all persons in the household. Remember that persons of different population groups do sometimes form part of the same household so you cannot assume the population group for people who are not present at the interview.

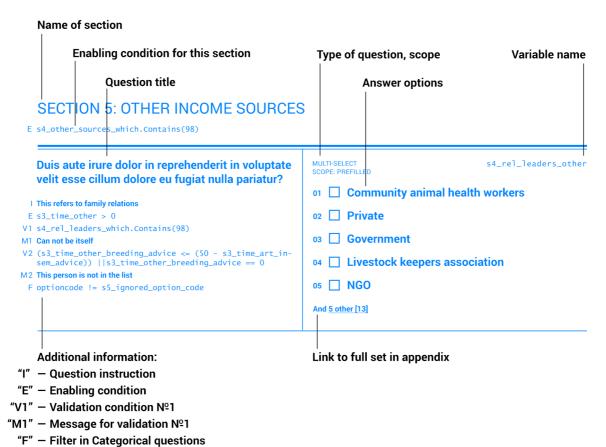


